IMPORTANT NOTE:

The Tournament shall include men's singles and doubles, women's singles and doubles, and mixed doubles in the following age groups: 35+, 40+, 45+, 50+, 55+, 60+, 65+, and 70+ and 75+, 80+ with other age groups to be added at the discretion of BWF on a case-by-case basis.

Players should have reached the relevant age by **01 January of the year** in which the tournament is held. Therefore, for a player to play in an age category, 35+ to 80+, they need to have been born in or before the year shown in the chart above.

Number of Players from Each Member

Each Member shall be entitled to enter in each age group, up to 4 men and 4 women in singles events, 8 men and 8 women in doubles events, and 4 men and 4 women in mixed doubles event. The Additional entries for the Host are as table below,

Please submit a copy of the passport or ID Card of the Government Authority through this link, https://eu.jotform.com/230882465940058 The original documents may be checked during the tournament by BWF and / or the Referees. The BWF shall have the power to reject an entry due to incorrect date of birth or non-submission of the documents as stated above. The order of entries, as made by each Member in the online entry system, is considered to be the national ranking order for separation of entries. Entries with an existing World Ranking will prioritise over national ranking order. BWF will accept entries in doubles events as "Partner Wanted". Players who are keen to partner a player from different Member in the doubles event shall have to contact their Member sufficiently in advance for approval from both Members before the closing date.

Conduct of the Tournament

All draws where the number of entries is more than 16 are played in a knockout format. Where entries are up to 16 in an event of any age category, the event may be played as follows:

- If 1-5 entries: Group play only.
- If 6-16 entries: Group play followed by knock out.

The number of groups will be determined by the size of the final entries.

IMPORTANT NOTE:

if there are less than four entries in an event of any age group, the right is reserved to cancel that event. In such case, the players who have entered in that cancelled event will be eligible to enter in the same event in lower age group, provided there are entry spaces available.

There shall be one seeded entry per group as follows,

Separation of Entries

The Entries from any one Member shall be drawn as follows: If a knockout draw only (i.e., more than 16 entries):

- the first and second ranked entries from the Member are drawn by lot in opposite halves of the draw.
- the third and fourth ranked entries are drawn by lot in remaining quarters.

If group play only (i.e., 1-5 entries):

no national separation.

If group play followed by knock out (i.e., 6-16 entries):

The first and second ranked entries from the Member are drawn by lot into separate groups.
