Badminton Europe is happy to inform you that we will organise a BWF/BEC Level 1 Coach Education Course in Nicosia, Cyprus from 12 to 15 March 2020. The course is also open to coaches who work with Para-badminton players. The course is organised in close cooperation with the Cyprus Badminton Federation.

## Planning
